




Peachland underwent a "Technovation". This was a successful "TED Talk" style evening filled with tech-talent, experience and ideas.

FINANCE REPORT

2017 marked my first year as treasurer for the Chamber. This year we had a net loss on operations, but overall, the financial health of the organization remains positive.

Our bank account balance end of the year was \$10,938.

DID YOU KNOW?...

When you become a member of the Peachland Chamber of Commerce, you automatically become a member of the BC Chamber of Commerce and the Canadian Chamber of Commerce?



The Schapiro Group (based in Atlanta, Georgia) completed a research study on the real value of joining a local chamber of commerce. While all their findings were interesting, there were a few facts that stood out.

Joining a local chamber is an effective way to convey to consumers that a company uses good business practices, is involved in the community, cares about customers, and is reputable. The percentages in Table 1 show just how effective of a business strategy being active in a local chamber really is. For example, consumers say that being active in the local chamber is 29% more effective for communicating that a company uses good business practices than it is for making a general statement about the company.


